Seed House is a Non-Profit organization that we believe that ownership and accountability for one's own life establishes leadership and self-sufficiency in one's own life. We believe that having a safe and secure environment allows an individual to focus on personal development. Healthy neurodevelopment are predicated upon the establishment of close nurturing relationships and environmental stimulation. Involvement in the decision making of one's own life shows value to the young adult involved. By addressing the total well-being of a young adult you allow full restoration from past hurts, encourage critical thinking, and develop life and vocational skills.

Mentors primary responsibilities are:

As a mentor your responsibility will be to measure the progress of your mentee, and identify the areas of growth. The mentor will be responsible for monitoring the growth in each youth adults life. Build a personal relationship, with the purpose to execute proper transitioning into adulthood. The mentor should have great communication, and have an abundance of compassion and patience. Mentors should be able to view you as a partner in their journey of development. As a mentor you will be require to meet with your mentee once a weekly bases. We also ask that you will be available for your mentee to contact you regarding any question on personal development. All mentors will be required to submit a weekly log on the status of your mentee. All mentors will meet together every other week to discuss the barriers the mentee is reaching and brainstorm on concepts to reach their goal. Seed House Project will also be hosting a quarterly 2 day training to enhance the quality of our mentor program. All mentors are required to attend the training.
